

CODE OF CONDUCT

We enable **organizations/individual trainers** to enable effective learning sessions and specific roles are created to enable virtual e-learning sessions. As with any virtual environment we need to ensure that sessions that are managed online are safe for students, instructors and companies enabling the lessons. Please ensure that you check our company's [Terms of use](#) and [Privacy policy](#) in addition to following guidelines of the organization who enables the training.

GUIDELINES

- **Guidance** – The age restrictions for our website platform is 13+. For any virtual classes/sessions for ages below 13, the moderators must ensure that the parents are supervising the kids below 13 during the online sessions. Any registrations to sessions must be done by Adults 18+ or above.
- **Safety**-The session invites must maintain cordial safe environment for all age groups and any kind of profanity/hate speech/political speeches/nudity/gun promotions or lobbies including ANY form of unsafe or unethical content display, chats, videos or other form of such content is **strictly prohibited**.
- **Harassment**- We have a private secure metaverse but access various external text, images or other content via 3rd party API whose data we don't control. It is at discretion of all users not to use any demeaning, threatening, racist, abusive or hateful content towards any race, sex, religion.
- **Avatars** The platform allows you to choose specific avatar so that your personal information or name is not available in the session. Using a proxy name of another person or impersonation of any other individual not the actual person who registered is NOT allowed and strictly prohibited. **Moderators** must ensure safety of identity, personal info and any exchange of personal information via our platform collaboration tools.
- **Your and 3rd Party Content** Any kind of inflammatory content, hostile depictions, name calling, abusive text messages, nudity, porn or any harmful data import even temporarily into a session is not allowed. As we provide access to many third-party data API's including data shared by moderator organization we don't control that data and hence it must be used responsibly and moderators have the right to delete inappropriate content or content not viable to the session context during sessions.
- **Reporting** – Each session user has the right to report any issue to the moderator via their email or info@learnroll.com . Any unauthorized access or "hack" of a session must be immediately reported to us for redressal.
- **Moderator Instructions** You must follow moderator guidelines on how and when to post, import content, move so that session is not disrupted
- **Promotions/ advertising** Moderators must ensure that platform is used for training/classes and not to purely promote businesses, services, products of any guest/business self-interest. Any such services may be conducted in separate sessions not as part of any classroom training.
- **Copyright Infringement and Accreditation** - All copyright and accreditation must be followed. If you are using any 3rd party images, please follow any citations and copyright rules even for data or content that are deemed as FREE or covered with a CC license. Do not use any content that is not yours without permission or consent.
